## A Level Fieldwork at the Slapton Ley Field Centre, South Devon – 10-14 November 2025

A booking has been made for a residential field course at the Slapton Ley Field Centre, South Devon from **Monday 10 November to Friday 14 November 2025**.

It is a **formal requirement** for A level Geography that students complete a minimum of 4 days' practical fieldwork. During the first three days of the trip, students will be introduced to a range of geographical environments and taught key skills involved in undertaking fieldwork. On the fourth day students will carry out their own fieldwork in a location of their choice which will form the basis of their coursework investigation (NEA) which is **worth 20% of their final A level grade**. It is therefore important that Geography students attend this trip so that they can be supported in carrying out the fieldwork for their coursework.

We also know from experience that this residential practical course offers a real boost to social interaction through group work and discussion which are especially important in developing high level geographical understanding needed in the rest of the A level course.

The cost, based on 12 students, will be £665 which will include return transport from London Paddington, on-site transport, accommodation, full board, a specialist local tutor and the use of all educational facilities. This price is calculated using the estimated rail fare as group booking is not yet available for these dates. Any reduction in cost from an increased group size and/or discounted rail fare from group booking will be refunded at the end of the fieldtrip.

Further details of the transport arrangements, field centre and a full programme will be sent to you approximately four weeks before departure.

We now need to confirm our booking with the field centre and send a deposit of £300 per student. Please make this payment by Friday 19 September. The remaining £365 will be requested by Monday 13 October. It is a condition of the Fieldwork Centre that once your initial deposit is accepted the balance for the student will be payable in full. May I suggest that you take out your own cancellation insurance or check your annual policy, as the school will be unable to support such an event.

If you agree to the details of the trip outlined in this letter please make a payment of £300 for 'Slapton Ley Fieldwork' using the school's WisePay system by Friday 19 September (the offer will be available from the start of the autumn term). Please be aware that payment constitutes permission for this trip. If you have any
