Year 8 Residential Trip to Cuffley Camp & Activity Centre - 14-15 July 2025

I am sure you are excited to find out more about the Year 8 Newstead Wood School Summer Camp at Cuffley Camp & Activity Centre, Tolmers Road, Cuffley, Hertfordshire, EN6 4JS. Please find details below.

Activities

Set in over 100 acres of beautiful woodland, the natural setting of Cuffley Activity Learning Centre promotes development and growth through engaging outdoor activities.

Students will enjoy archery, abseiling, rock climbing, obstacle courses and a range of other outdoor adventure activities. All of this is undertaken under the supervision of experienced instructors.

Menu

The menu will be adapted according to dietary requirements of the group. Most meals will be "deconstructed" so students can have the parts they want; this also helps us cater for dietary needs. For example, the vegetable stir-fry and the noodles will be cooked separately, and the chicken and sauces will be added after by the participants, so they can choose what they want on it.

Students should bring their own packed lunch for the first day.

This two-day, one night camping trip is a fantastic opportunity for students to learn camping skills and outdoor education in a safe setting. The site has a fully plumbed toilet block with toilets, running water and showers.

Equipment:
